3	Great Crested Grebe	Podiceps cristatus	Seen on 4 days with maximum of 8 on one day.
4	Great Cormorant	Phalacrocorax carbo	Seen flying over on 5 days with biggest group of six on the last morning in Goniadz.
5	Great Egret	Egretta alba alba	Seen on 4 days with a huge count of 200 in the wetlands at Rus.
6	Gray Heron	Ardea cinerea	Seen in small numbers up to 10 on 7 days.
7	Great Bittern	Botaurus stellaris	Several birds heard giving their "Booming" call from large reedbeds on 3 days. One seen by Bernie flying over a marsh.
8	Black Stork	Ciconia nigra	Seen on 4 days with max of 8 at various sites including Rus, on the 29 th .
9	White Stork	Ciconia ciconia	Common. Many seen every day including several close nests with young.
10	Mute Swan	Cygnus olor	Seen in small numbers on 7 days.
11	Whooper Swan	Cygnus cygnus	One with a numbered neck band seen at Pulwy.
12	Greylag Goose	Anser anser	A few seen on 3 days.
13	Greater White-fronted Goose	Anser albifrons	A lone bird was seen at Pulwy.
14	Gadwall	Anas strepera	Just the odd one or two seen on 4 days
15	Common Teal	Anas crecca	Singles seen on two days.

146	Common Rosefinch	Carpodacus erythrinus	Heard a lot on 6 days and seen some nice males seen at various sites.
147	Red Crossbill	Loxia curvirostra	A couple flew over calling at Kosy Most but not really tickable views!
148	Hawfinch	Coccothraustes coccothraustes	Seen in flight a few times and eventually seen feeding on a track in the restricted reserve, Bialowieza.
149	Yellowhammer	Emberiza citrinella	Common and seen in small numbers every day.
150	Ortolan Bunting	Emberiza hortulana	One seen well on wires at Brzostowo and another seen at disused quarry near Tykocin.
151	Reed Bunting	Emberiza schoeniclus	A few seen at reed bed sites on 5 days.
152	Corn Bunting	Miliaria calandra	Seen well around Nowogrod at start of tour.

1	European Beaver	Castor fiber	Some fresh gnawings and a couple of dams seen but no animals.
2	Elk	Alces alces	A very distant one at Lawki Marsh from boardwalk and another close one but pretty much ears only at Bialowieza.
3	Roe Deer	Capreolus capreolus	A few seen on 4 days around Bialowieza.
4	Red Deer	Cervus elaphus	Seen on 2 days including a nice view at Kosy Most in morning.
5	Brown Hare	Lepus capensis	Seen on 4 days and often just ears sticking up in a field.
6	Martin?	Martes or Mustela?	A Martin species ran across the road one morning near Bialowieza. Too far away to identify it could have been Pine Martin, Beech Martin or even a Mink.

16	Map Butterfly	Araschnia levana	Just one seen well at Kosy Most.
17	Heath Fritillary	Melitaea athalia	A couple at Roller site.
18	Meadow Brown	Maniola jurtina	A few seen around meadows.
19	Ringlet	Aphantopus hyperantus	One or two near Roller site.

11	Hairy Hawker	Brachytron pratense	Common and widespread with countless sightings including mating pairs at Osowiec.
12	Common Clubtail	Gomphus vulgatissimus	Seen by Lock Gate and also Osowiec.
13	Downy Emerald	Cordulia aenea	Very common and literally hundreds seen hawking insects over forest clearing around Bialowieza, in particular Kosy Most.
14	Brilliant Emerald	Somatochlora metallica	None confirmed except a dead one in the mouth of a White Wagtail.
15	Four-spotted Chaser	Libellula quadrimaculata	Seen on 4 or 5 days and common around Bialowieza.
16	Broad-bodied Chaser	Libellula depressa	Just a couple seen.
17	Blue Chaser	Libellula fulva	Reasonably common at Kosy Most.
18	Yellow-spotted Whiteface	Leucorrhinia pectoralis	Seen in good numbers at several sites including Pulwy.
