| 9 | Northern Pintail | Anas acuta | 4 | 80 | 1 st seen at Leonabelle Turnbull Birding Center, Port Aransas |
| 10 | Green-winged Teal | Anas crecca | 3 | 450 | 1 st at Leonabelle Turnbull Birding Ctr and Wetland's Park |
| 11 | Redhead | Aythya americana | 4 | 500 | Common in the Oso Bay- Corpus area! |
| 12 | Ring-necked Duck | Aythya collaris | 1 | 2 | In roadside puddle on Mustang Island. Not common |
| 13 | Lesser Scaup | Aythya affinis | 5 | 10 | Mustang Island, S. Padre Isle, etc. |
| 14 | Surf Scoter | <u>Melanitta</u> perspicillata | 1 | 2 | # 197 Swantner Park; 2 females by breakwater with female Black Scoter |
| 15 | Black Scoter* (rare in TX) | <u>Melanitta</u> <u>americana</u> | 1 | 1 | Female; Rare. New for Frank in TX. #196 |
| 16 | Bufflehead | Bucephala albeola | 2 | 3 | JFK Causeway, Oso Bay, Corpus. |

| 21 | Scaled Quail | Callipepla squamata | 2 | 6 | Heard at Falcon State Park; seen on Salineño - Old Dump Road – difficult! |
| 22 | Wild Turkey | Meleagris gallopavo | 3 | 14 | Bentsen on roadside near feeders |
| 23 | Rock Pigeon | Columba livia | 6 | 50 | Widespread but not as common in some areas as expected |
| 24 | Red-billed Pigeon* | Patagioenas flavirostris | 1 | 2 | Third try was the charm. Great looks at Salineño as they flew back and forth from Mexico. |
| 25 | Eurasian Collared-Dove | Streptopelia decaocto | 3+ | 200 | Nana's Taqueria has a stellar population nearby. More seen in transit but not recorded. |
| 26 | Inca Dove* | Columbina inca | 3 | 17 | Our introduction to these cuties was at Hazel Bazemore |
| 27 | Common Ground Dove | Columbiana passerina | 1 | 1 | Flew by the group at Knolle Farm. Hard to find this year. Never common |
| 28 | White-tipped Dove* | Leptotila verreauxi | 5 | 5 | Our first was at Laguna Vista Nature Trail Blind #3 within minutes of arrival |
| 29 | White-winged Dove* | Zenaida asiatica | 5 | 47 | Fairly common in the valley. Many at Salineño. |
| 30 | Mourning Dove | Zenaida macroura | 5 | 24 | Fairly common |
| 31 | Groove-billed Ani* | Crotophaga sulcirostris | 1 | 1 | Great looks as we were leaving at Laguna Vista Nature Trail |
| 32 | Greater Roadrunner | Geococcyx californianus | 2 | 5 | Fantastic experience at Falcon State Park |
| 33 | Common Pauraque* | Nyctidromus albicollis | 2 | 6 | Fantastic views at Estero Llano! 1 seen & 6 heard at Santa Margarita |
| 34 | Ruby-throated Hummingbird | <u>Archilochus</u> <u>colubris</u> | 2 | 2 | First at Clay Taylor's house |
| 35 | Black-chinned Hummingbird | Archilochus alexandri | 2 | 1 | First at Estero Llano Grande |

| 96 | Sharp-shinned Hawk | Accipiter striatus | 3 | 2 | Uncommon; first at Salineño (bombed feeders at one point) |
| 97 | Cooper's Hawk | Accipiter cooperii | 3 | 1 | 1st at Leonabelle Turnbull NC |
| 98 | Northern Harrier | Circus hudsonius | 5 | 2 | Seen first at Hazel Bazemore |
| 99 | Harris's Hawk* | Parabuteo unicinctus | 5 | 3 | Widespread and a lovely raptor! |
| 100 | White-tailed Hawk* | Geranoaetus albicaudatus | 3 | 4 | 4 perched on poles near Aplomado Falcon towers on Mustang Island! |
| 101 | Gray Hawk* | Buteo plagiatus | 4 | 5 | First seen at Nat Butterfly Center! |
| 102 | Red-shouldered Hawk | Buteo lineatus | 1 | 1 | Adult seen from the hawk platform and at Hazel Bazemore |
| 103 | Red-tailed Hawk | Buteo jamaicensis | 6 | 5 | Seen nearly daily, including Fuertes (pale-bellied) birds |
| 104 | American Barn Owl | <u>Tyto furcata</u> | 1 | 1 | Great looks at 1 at Chapman Ranch |
| 105 | "McCall's" Eastern Screech-Owl | Megascops asio mccallii | 1 | 6 | A South Texas subspecies seen at Estero Llano Grande in its shed. Heard and seen at Santa Margarita |

| 110 | Belted Kingfisher | Megaceryle alcyon | 4 | 3 | Scattered sightings; 1st at JFK Causeway Wetlands |
| 111 | Green Kingfisher* | Chloroceryle americana | 3 | 3 | Incredible views of one at a pair at Edinburg Scenic Wetlands!! |
| 112 | Yellow-bellied Sapsucker | <u>Sphyrapicus varius</u> | 3 | 1 | First at Oliveira Park, Brownsville |
| 113 | Golden-fronted Woodpecker* | Melanerpes aurifrons | 6 | 11 | What beauties. 1 st at Hazel Bazemore |
| 114 | Ladder-backed Woodpecker* | Dryobates scalaris | 6 | 5 | Seen or heard almost daily; 1 st was at Hazel Bazemore |
| 115 | Crested Caracara* | Caracara cheriway | 7 | 10 | We shall never forget the Brownsville Landfill. 1 st at Chapman Ranch-day 1. |
| 116 | American Kestrel | Falco sparverius | 7 | 6 | Common on the wires |
| 117 | Merlin | Falco columbarius | 3 | 2 | First at JFK Causeway; 2 at Oliveira |
| 118 | Aplomado Falcon* | Falco femoralis | 2 | 3 | Our first views were on the hack tower day two. 3 perched on the return trip. Mustang Island, |
| 119 | Peregrine Falcon | Falco peregrinus | 1 | 1 | Salineño; circled and went down river |
| 120 | Monk Parakeet | Myiopsitta monachus | 3 | 20 | Best looks at 4 perched at Oliveira |
| 121 | White-fronted Amazon** (provisional) | Amazona albifrons | 1 | 55 | 4 teed up on a wire by the bathroom at Oliveira Park; joined in try by 53! |
| 122 | Red-crowned Parrot* | Amazona viridigenalis | 1 | 130 | Put on quite the show at Oliveira |
| LO | Red-lored Amazon** (provisional) | Amazona autumnalis | 1 | 2 | Quick flyby at Oliveira. Leaders Only |
| 123 | Green Parakeet* | Psittacara holochlorus | 1 | 7 | Flying around Olive Garden at 1st light |
| 124 | Rose-throated Becard | <u>Pachyramphus</u> <u>aglaiae</u> | 2 | 1 | Great looks at young male at Santa Ana and adult male at Salineño! |
| 125 | Black Phoebe* | Sayornis nigricans | 2 | 2 | Pair at Salineño on the dead snag |
| 126 | Eastern Phoebe | Sayornis phoebe | 8 | 2 | Seen daily in small numbers |

| 130 | Cattle Tyrant** (provisional) | <u>Machetornis rixosa</u> | 1 | 1 | Incredible looks as it walked among us in Corpus Christi; not yet accepted |
| 131 | Tropical Kingbird* | Tyrannus melancholicus | 3 | 5 | Great views of our first at Laguna Vista Nature Trail near entrance |
| 132 | Couch's Kingbird* | Tyrannus couchii | 2 | 1 | One calling while perched at Hazel Bazemore & at Oliveira Park. Tours missed this bird. |
| 133 | White-eyed Vireo | Vireo griseus | 3 | 2 | Best views in thickets at Falcon SP |
| 134 | Blue-headed Vireo | Vireo solitarius | 3 | 4 | 1 st at Hazel Bazemore; 3 at BV Cem |
| 135 | Loggerhead Shrike* | Lanius ludovicianus | 8 | 10 | Seen daily and well |
| 136 | Brown Jay* (Mega) | Cyanocorax morio | 1 | 4 | These Mex rarities vanish for years at a time. Killer views - Santa Margarita |
| 137 | Green Jay* | Cyanocorax yncas | 6 | 22 | Nothing says you're in South Texas like these incredible creatures! I never get tired of seeing them. |
| 138 | Chihuahuan Raven* | Corvus cryptoleucus | 1 | 14 | Brownsville Landfill party. Surprisingly inconspicuous otherwise |
| 139 | Black-crested Titmouse* | Baeolophus atricristatus | 6 | 11 | 1 st at Hazel Bazemore – cuties |
| 140 | Verdin* | Auriparus flaviceps | 2 | 4 | Great looks at roadside in Fronton! |
| 141 | Horned Lark | <u>Eremophila</u> <u>alpestris</u> | 1 | 20 | Chapman Ranch on day 1 |
| 142 | Northern Rough-winged Swallow | Stelgidopteryx serripennis | 2 | 1 | Flying around at Salineño a traditional site for them. |
| 143 | Barn Swallow | Hirundo rustica | 1 | 2 | Flying together upriver - Roma Bluffs |
| 144 | Cave Swallow | Petrochelidon fulva | 3 | 11 | First at Hazel; best looks at Edinburg |
| 145 | Ruby-crowned Kinglet | Regulus calendula | 7 | 9 | Common in the valley; First at Leonabelle. |
| 146 | Blue-gray Gnatcatcher | Polioptila caerulea | 6 | 9 | 1 st in Clay Taylor's yard |
| 147 | Northern House Wren | Troglodytes aedon | 3 | 3 | 1st was at Edinburg Scenic Wetlands |

| 155 | Long-billed Thrasher* | Toxostoma longirostre | 4 | 4 | Seen well 1 st at feeders at Clay's; also at Laguna Vista and elsewhere |
